THE CANADIAN HISTORY HALL

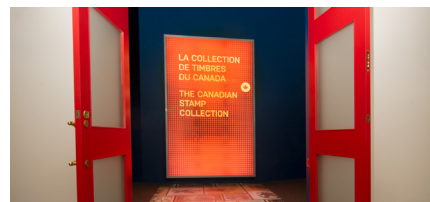
Experience Canada's history in exciting new ways.

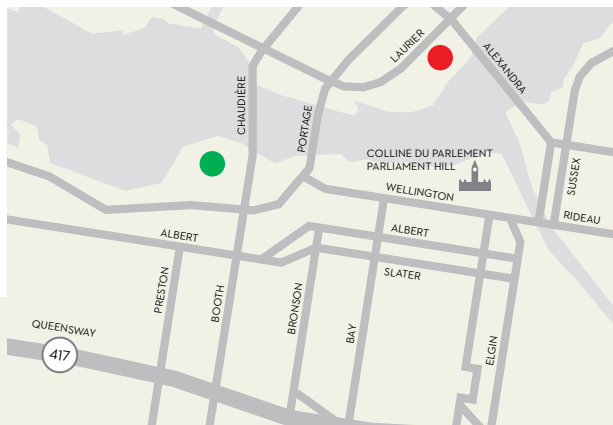
